

FLEXIBLE FILM RECYCLING PROGRAM FAQ

What is this program?

1-800-GOT-JUNK? and the Flexible Film Recycling Alliance (FFRA) are providing collection and recycling services for flexible plastic film generated by participating businesses. The program will run July 1 through December 31, 2026.



WHAT MATERIALS ARE ACCEPTED?

- Stretch wrap
- Shrink wrap
- Pallet wrap
- Polyethylene overwrap
- Bubble wrap
- Shipping air pillows
- Dry cleaning bags
- Plastic grocery bags
- Newspaper bags
- Appliance wrap
- Furniture wrap

All materials must be clean and dry.

HOW IT WORKS

- Collect accepted film from participating locations
- Check for non-accepted items
- Determine what, if any, additional supplies are needed
- Transport accepted material to the warehouse
- Weigh and record material
- Bale and store (if trained on baler)
- Store in a clean, dry location
- Report any issues

- ✓ Deliver Rack'n'Pak collection systems
- ✓ Collect full bags of film
- ✓ Weigh and record collected material
- ✓ Leave replacement bags as needed
- ✓ Report contamination or equipment issues
